SNEC's Coastwest funded southern coastal foreshore restoration project is proceeding well. In collaboration with City of Stirling and also receiving continued support from Perth Region NRM, Corporate and Landcare contacts. The timeframe of this project runs through to the end of October 2014 and is part of a three year plan for the area. Strengthening the health and restoring the integrity of these dunes contributes to long term resilience and increases future adaptive opportunities. Monitoring and maintenance continues on all sites.

NEW infrastructure replacement

At Watermans Bay main Beach



The vehicle ramp is being replaced with stairs keyed down onto buried inshore reef. Considerable reinstatement of frontal dune vegetation will now be required.

After much consideration the City has approved for placement in its 2014-15 Budget, preparation of a 'Concept Design' as preliminary requirement prior to replacement of the Toilet/ changerooms Facility removed some years ago from behind the old jetty fishing platform to the old Apex Hall previously the old North Beach Surf Club demolition site. Community will have to 'hold on' for a little longer yet!

Also underway in 2014

Refurbishment of Watermans Bay Marine Centre into the Watermans Bay Marine Research Centre into
'Indian Ocean Marine Research Institute'

After completion SNEC will be assisting in integrating the building's landscape with the surrounding areas.

Planting for 2014

will start as soon as sufficient rain dampens the soil and this is usually some time in May maybe running into June. SNEC likes to be ready early to take advantage of any early heavy showers. Many associated activities take place around at this time and involve both our new project sites and infill planting. These activities will continue until all plants are in and protected.
